For the reason that they slip directly onto the blades, universal fit buckets stay on the equipment and are less vulnerable to destruction. Compared to the quick-tach container models, universal fit buckets are 50 percent. This extra space makes them ideal for lifting irregular shaped loads like for example broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing off roof trash, elevating roof gravel and moving large debris piles.

The Quick-Tach is able to dump stuff approximately 1.5 feet higher thanks to the shorter depth of its bucket.
